

Tax Credits and Exemptions Overview

All applications for Exemptions and Credits must be filed by April 15th, and not afterwards, for the current tax year. The application is permanent as long as you own your home or until your financial circumstances change. The Board of Assessors may review your application during subsequent tax years to determine continuation of eligibility. You must notify the Assessing Staff if you no longer qualify because of changes in income or assets.

Change of Residence: In the event of a property owner who receives and exemption/credit sells his property and purchases another at a later date within the City of Somersworth, or moves to another property owned by him, the **property owner** has the responsibility of notifying the Assessing Office in order to continue receiving the exemption/credit. A new application will need to be submitted to the Assessing Office for review.
