All parks will be listed on the city website detailing the types of recreation available.

Miscellaneous: Staff reports that paving of Skateboard Park is complete but work was unsatisfactory. Vender was contacted and returned, repairs were still unsatisfactory. Payment is being withheld until work is completed satisfactorily. Vender advises too cold to complete until spring. Unfinished structures secured until spring so no one can be hurt.

Previously donated fencing at Noble Pines baseball field is in disrepair. Staff is requested to report of exactly what needs to be done with it, remove, replace or repair and estimated costs.
