TRUSTEES MEETING

APRIL 8, 2014

MEMBERS PRESENT; WOODY OPENO, MARY GRAVES, MARY SHAW, FRANK KENNEDY, PWD. JENNIFER NALLEY AND TEMP DIRECTOR CAROL MURRAY. ABSENT.. JENNIE FLAYHAN STILL RECOVERING FROM INJURIES FROM FALL.

MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY CHAIRMAN WOODY AT 4:00 PM WITH A CORRECTION OF THE NAME OF SOMERSWORTH VOC. TECH. TEACHER AS SCOTT MORRIS. MINUTES OF MARCH WERE READ AND ACCEPTED BY ALL PRESENT.

THE TRUSTEES WERE NOTIFIED BY CAROL THAT THE PROPOSAL OF HAVING A GROUP OF VOLUNTEERS FROM LIBERTY MUTUAL TO WORK IN FOREST GLADE WAS NOT APPROVED FOR THIS SPRING, WE WILL TRY AGAIN NEXT SPRING. CAROL NOTED THAT THEY'LL LOOK INTO HAVING THE PRISONER WORK PROGRAM INSTEAD
