APRIL 9, 2013

MEMBERS PRESENT; DAVID EASTMAN, JENNIE FLAYHAN, MARY GRAVES, FRANK KENNEDY, WOODY OPENO, WITH JENNIFER NALLEY AND TOM WILLIS ATTENDING.

4:00 PM. DAVID CALLED MEETING TO ORDER. WITH A REMINDER OF THE 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF USS THRESHER SINKING CAUSING THE DEATH OF 129 PEOPLE . ON APRIL 10, 1963. THE FLAG AT THE MEMORIAL SITE IS 129 FEET HIGH AND THE PLAQUE WAS DESIGNED BY THE DAUGHTER OF DANIEL BEAL JR. ONE OF THE LOST MEMBER'S, IT CERTAINLY WAS A SAD AND TRAGIC TIME FOR NEW HAMPSHIRE PEOPLE ,

NEXT ON THE AGENDA WAS A DISCUSSION ON THE CREMATION AREA, THE PREPROPOSED AREA WAS ALREADY DESIGNED IN A CIRCLE OF FOUR COLUMNS, TO BE SOLD IN A UNIFORMED MANNER STARTING IN THE CIRCLE AND WORKING AROUND EACH COLUMN., ALSO PROPOSED AT THE TIME IN 2008 , WAS THE POSSIBILITY OF PLANTING FLOWERS IN BETWEEN THE COLUMNS WHEN AND IF TIME AND FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE..

TOM SPOKE WITH MR. MORRISON CONCERNING GRUB CONTROL UNFORTUNATELY COST-WISE IS NOT IN THE BUDGET. HE THEN RECOMMENDED AN IN-HOUSE EMPLOYEE TO BE CERTIFIED TO DO THE JOB AND WORK WITH THE NEW LANDSCAPER, MR. GREGOIRE. WOODY GAVE A GOOD EXAMPLE OF WHAT WAS GOING ON IN CERTAIN AREAS WITH THE GRUBS AND CERTAINLY GETTING WORSE, HE FEELS THAT NOTHING IS BEING ACCOMPLISHED BY THE CITY-- WE ALL WOULD LIKE TO SEE SOME PROGRESS THIS SPRING.

TOM WILL CONTACT UNH ABOUT CLASSES NEEDED FOR CERTIFICATION, IF FEASIBLE FOR IN-HOUSE EMPLOYEE... AND ALSO MAYBE WORK WITH MR. MORRISON WITH SOME ON-SITE TRAINING.

WOODY DID A WALK THRU HORNE ST. CEMETERY AND NOTICED A VERY LARGE TREE BENT OVER CLOSE TO THE GROUND, THAT MAYBE SHOULD BE TAKEN DOWN, FOR SAFETY SAKE AT LEAST. TOM DID SAY THERE WAS TREE REMOVAL FUNDS AVAILABLE AND HE WILL CHECK INTO THIS.

DAVID MENTIONED ABOUT A SMALL RECEPTION FOR MEMBERS AND ANY GUESTS PRESENT WHEN MOSES TOMB IS COMPLETED , WITH JOHN WASTROM, NEWS REPORTERS AND WOODY WILL TRY TO CONTACT FAMILY MEMBERS ALSO, LIKE THE GREAT GRANDAUGHTER, SO AS TO HAVE A SPECIFIC DATE THAT WILL BE GOOD FOR EVERYONE....WE WILL BE HAVING A SPECIAL MEETING ON MAY 7TH TO MAKE DEFINITE PLANS AHEAD..


DAVID MENTIONED THAT JOHN E. STRAW'S STONE IS IN NEED OF SOME FIXING.. IT.
