

Somersworth Forest Glade Cemetery  
Trustees Committee Meeting

December 11, 2012

Members present; David Eastman, Mary Graves, Frank Kennedy, Woody Openo,  
Jennie Flayhan; Tom Willis and Jennifer Nalley of Public Works Dept.

4:00 pm. Meeting was called to order by Chairman David. Minutes were read and accepted by all.  
Jennifer was in contact with Mr Wastrom, and would like his remaining work project  
to be kept on a low key as to the public viewing, i.e. Foster's Democrat, due to the dangerous process of  
moving the large stones into place, so as to avoid any unwanted incidents.

Woody will get in touch with Mary Pat Rowland of Fosters to let her know when the time is right for  
questions and pictures. He said he would be the spokesperson for the history of the tomb.

John still needs the key to the tomb, Jennifer will ask Ray Morin where it could have been stored.

David again reminded us that the Horne St. cemetery is the responsibility of the City since Mrs Furbish,  
who originally owned the property, turned it over to the City, with the requisit from the Ladies Club that  
the City put a fence around the stones, it was never done. And in spite of the many request of doing  
cleaning up and maybe restoration on a small scale, we have not had any good response except there is no  
money. Frank will bring in a notebook he has on the cemetery at the next meeting, he will also make some  
inquiries on frequent visitors of the past years if any relatives are still living,

Discussion was had concerning an increase of \$50.00 on winter burials, of child graves and cremations.

Everyone was in agreement.

Cemetery will be closed around Christmas and New Years except for Jewish burials or certain special occasion.  
And will not re-open until Spring of 2013.

Mary ask if street signs have been found? Not yet.

Tom reminded us this is budget time, we need to put ideas or  
recommendation...for repairs... maintenance ... well houses are already in the budget to be repaired in the  
Spring, also some pine trees in No. west area in back. We can have either Urban Tree or Burkes Tree  
Service.

Woody commented that the grub problem needs to be addressed.

Tom said a City-wide mowing contract will be put out with provision for pest control to be included.

Meeting was adjourned at 5:15 pm
