MAY 13, 2014

PRESENT: WOODY OPENO, FRANK KENNEDY, MARY GRAVES, MARY SHAW,

MEETING TOOK PLACE AT FOREST GLADE CHAPEL AT 4:00 PM. FOLLOWING SOME OBSERVATIONS OF THE PAINTED WELLHOUSE NEARBY, WOODY TOOK SOME PICTURES. WITH SOME CONVERSATION ON THE REPAINTING, WHICH BEN INFORMED US OF, POSSIBILITY OF THE OLD PAINT COULD BE LEAD AND WE WOULD NEED TO KNOW THE RULES FROM EPA ON THE REMOVAL OF THAT PAINT BEFORE NEW PAINT WAS APPLIED. BEN WILL GET MORE INFO ON THIS MATTER, AS WELL AS, ALL PERMITS NEEDED TO DO THE WORK ON THE RUSTIC WELLHOUSE WITH HIS STUDENTS. JENNIFER WILL BE GOING THROUGH FILES FOR ANY PAPER WORK REGARDING THE LAST TIME THE WELLHOUSE WAS PAINTED AND CALL PAM CONSTANCE IN FINANCE TO LOOK UP FUNDS THAT MAY HAVE BEEN ALLOCATED FOR THE MATERIALS. THESE REPAIRS SHOULD BE DONE BEFORE THE END OF THE BUDGET YEAR, WHICH IS JUNE 30, 2014.

WOODY INFORMED US THAT HE WAS STILL TRYING TO GET IN CONTACT WITH BOB YOKE, FROM NO.BERWICK, WHO IS SUPPOSE TO BE FIXING THE LOCK TO THE MOSES TOMB.

AS FAR AS THE CORNERSTONS THAT WERE STOLEN, FRANK WILL BE TALKING WITH ERNIE BLAISDELL FOR MORE INFO.

WOODY EXPLAINED THE RULES CONCERNING MEMBERSHIP TO THE HISTORICAL PRESERVATION SOCIETY. WOULD HAVE MUCH TO DO WITH THE UPKEEP OF THE HISTORY OF THE CEMETERY, HENCE, ONE OF MANY REASONS FOR THESE REPAIRS TO BE DONE BEFORE APPLYING FOR MEMBERSHIP.
