MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MR. EASTMAN.
MINUTES WERE READ AND ACCEPTED BY ALL AND JENN'S MEMO ON CEMETERY NEWS WITH ALL ITEMS REVIEWED AND ACCEPTED . WITH MORE DISCUSSION ON THE RESIDENT ON VERONA ST. WHO IS WILLING TO DO SOME CLEANING ON STONES USING A BRUSH. JENN HAD A LIST OF PRODUCTS THAT ARE APPROVED AND SOME ITEMS NOT RECOMMENDED. SUCH AS WIRE BRUSHES, METAL INSTRUMENTS, ABRASIVE PADS SUCH AS BRILLO OR STEEL WOOL PADS, ALSO CERTAIN HOUSEHOLD CLEANERS THAT ARE ABRASIVE.. WE WILL HAVE TO CONTACT MR. FLEISHER WITH THESE RULES.

JENN ALSO GAVE US ALL COPIES OF STATE LAWS FROM NH CEMETERY ASSOC. WITH A REGISTRATION FORM IF WE ARE INTERESTED IN ATTENDING A FUTURE TRUSTEES SESSION IN CONCORD. OR SHELBURNE, NH.

FRANK HAD GIVEN US A COPY OF SOME OF THESE LAWS. WE NEED TO GO OVER THESE LAWS AND MAYBE MAKE SOME EFFORT TO ATTEND ONE OF THESE SESSIONS . IT WOULD BE BENEFICIAL TO US ALL.


