

## Somersworth Conservation Commission Meeting Minutes

**Wednesday, November 12, 2014**, the meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Members Present: Imants Miller (acting Chairperson), Dave Sharples, Jeremy Rhodes, Dale Smith-Kenyon, Scott Orzechowski, Angela Ficco

- 1) Approval of meeting minutes –
  - a. July 9, 2014 minutes: changed line D from September 30, **2014** to **2015**, then approved with a motion by Jeremy Rhodes and a second by Scott, all in favor
  - b. August 13, 2014 minutes: motioned for approval by Jeremy Rhodes, second by Scott Orzechowski, all in favor
  - c. September 10, 2014: minutes not available for review
- 2) OLD BUSINESS - none
- 3) NEW BUSINESS
  - A) John J. Flatley sought a conditional use permit for work within the wetland buffer on property located on Tri City Road, in the Business (B) District, Assessor's Map 39, Lot 03, CUP #03-2014. There was an explanation of the proposed project. There was a lengthy question and answer period. It was determined that a site walk would be scheduled for November 22, 2014, 8 a.m..
  - B) It was decided that we would invite a representative from the New Hampshire Association of Conservation Commissions to speak to us about the benefits of membership prior to voting on disbursing funds for a 2015 membership. Dave Sharples will contact Nik Coates from NHACC to arrange this.

    - 1.) Scott Orzechowski and Angela Ficco attended the 44<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting for the NHACC
    - 2.) Angela Ficco mentioned a Speaking for Wildlife series that NH Coverts Project Volunteers (through the UNH Cooperative Extension) provide free of charge. These presentations are designed to promote the protection and conservation of NH's plant and animal wildlife.

    - 1.) The funds have been received for the Salmon Falls Road trails project. However, an archeological exam must be done prior to construction in order to satisfy DHR requirements.
