 - The scale of plans should be 1" = 50' to 1" = 100' scale to provide sufficient detail of the project site and its features;
 - Field delineated and surveyed streams, springs, seeps, bodies of water, and wetlands (include a minimum of 200 feet into adjacent properties) with the direction of flow show n;
 - Field delineated and surveyed riparian and wetland buffers, with plans signed and stamped by a certified wetland scientist and a licensed professional surveyor;
 - Limits of the 100-year floodplain
 - Hydric soils mapped in accordance with NRCS soil survey of the site area;
 - Slopes greater than 20 percent as measured over a ten foot interval for all lands within the Riparian and Wetland Buffer District;
 - Tree inventory in accordance with the standards of Section 6 of the Riparian and Wetland Buffer District Ordinance;
 - A narrative of the species and distribution of existing vegetation within the buffer; and,
 - Any other exhibits or data that the Conservation Commission or Planning Board may require in order to adequately evaluate the proposed development in accordance with Section 13 Riparian and Wetland Buffer District Ordinance.
- 9. A filing fee of \$100.00 (one hundred dollars) and the current rate for certified mail (check or money order made payable to the City of Somersworth) is required with submission of this application form to cover administrative costs, advertising and notification of abutters.
