

CHAPTER 2

Section 2.1:

The City Clerk shall be ex-officio keeper of the City seal, but shall permit the Mayor or any officer to affix the same to any document to which the City seal is required to be affixed.

Section 2.2:

All deeds and other legal instruments made, or special contract entered into by the City, requiring a seal, shall be sealed with the City seal and be signed and acknowledged in behalf of the City by the City Manager.

(Passed 11/15/93.)

Section 2.3:

The design shall consist of a disc of the size of a silver half dollar, with a smaller circle within which shall give a space 1/8 inch between the circles, whereon shall be engraved: Incorporated a Parish 1729. A Town 1754. A City 1893. Spanning the circle horizontally shall be a bar 1/8 inch wide, with the name of the City engraved thereon in bold letters. In the space above the bar, on the left, shall be engraved an old meeting house, and on the right, a view of the falls of the Salmon Falls River, also a locomotive and cars. Below the bar shall be engraved a view of a mill.

The device thereof being as follows:

Explanation: The old meeting house and falls suggest the source from which the town and village derive their names, while the mill gives an idea of the principal industry and the train suggests transportation facilities.
