1. Approval of Meeting Minutes: March 27, 2019

Ed Levasseur moved and Doug Watson seconded the motion to accept the minutes. Motion was approved.

2. Idle Reduction Proposal:

Ed presented an update on anti-idling rules. There is a question as to whether anti-idling is an enforceable, or fineable offense. Once that question is answered the proposal can be sent to the Government Operations Committee.

3. Energy Star Portfolio Manager:

Everyone has set up an account, but not everybody has accepted Scott's invitation to his "property."
